Patrick McCarthy sensei - martial arts expert, outstanding competitor, book author (e.g. "Bubishi – The Bible of Karate") and seminar instructor of worldwide renown – is going to teach another international seminar in Dresden. Martial artists of any style are welcome to experience his in-depth understanding of kata bunkai as he is going to teach the perhaps oldest kata of karate: Kūshankū 公相君. A learning opportunity you would not want to miss! Versions of this kata (also known as Kankū dai 観空大 or Kankū shō 観空小) are

still taught today in Shōtōkan ryū, Shitō ryū and Okinawan Shōrin ryū. Its history can be traced back to the Ōshima hikki of 1762. In these "Records of Ōshima" an exceptional Chinese martial artist called "Kōshankin" is mentioned. The kata Kūshankū was practiced and taught by historically significant karate experts such as Yara, Sakugawa, Matsumura and Itosu, which is why the kata belongs to the core of the Okinawan-Japanese martial art doubtlessly.
